Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors: Score higher on your ACT! We will be conducting an ACT workshop designed to assist students in preparing for the ACT college admissions test. This course is only being offered to Ripon



Christian students to maintain a small class size, insuring individual attention to participants. The workshops will cover the four major components of this test: English, Mathematics, Reading Comprehension, and Science Reasoning. The workshops

will cover subject matter tested by these four components as well as testing strategies. They will also prepare students by using actual ACT test questions that have appeared in the past. The workshops are scheduled for Saturday, March 12 and March 19, from 8:30-11:30 and 12:30-3:30 with a one hour lunch break. In addition, the course will include one practice exam, simulating the actual testing environment on March 26 (this will be a date agreed upon by the students in the class). This practice test date will also provide students with an opportunity to fully discuss the exam as well as answer miscellaneous questions regarding materials covered and useful testing strategies. Comparable exam prep courses run from \$500 to \$1000.

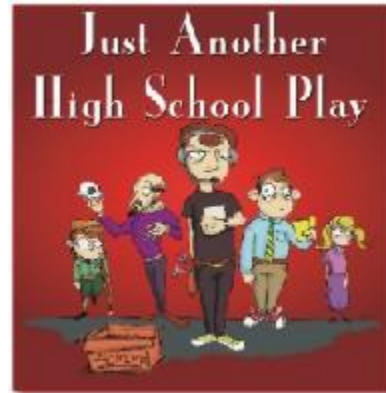

Caps and gowns will arrive later.



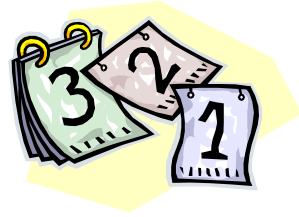
NEWS FROM TRIP: Anyone who purchases scrip between February 8th – 11th will be automatically entered into the Valentines drawing.
