PLEASE remember to call the high school office by 9:30 a.m. if your student is absent. A voice message can be left at extension 201 at any time.

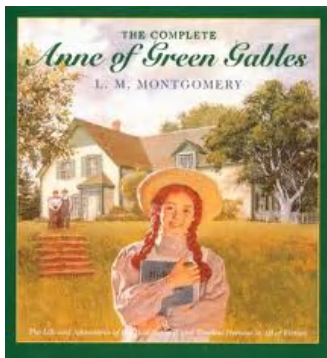

Food Drive for Ripon Interfaith Ministries

Each year we as a high school, collect food for Ripon Interfaith Ministries. We supply them much of the food needed to help them with this distribution for the Thanksgiving season. Each 1st period class will collect as many complete meals as they can. In the past, some classes have collected money and a few students go shopping for the meals, others have people bring as many food items as they can, it is up to each 1st period class to decide. All food items must be to school by the beginning of the school day on Tuesday, November 16. These items must be brought to your 1st period class with you. The 1st period class with the most complete meals in relation to the number of students in the class will be the winner of our competition.

A complete meal consists of:

- 1 turkey (10-14 lbs.) or 1 ham (5 lbs.)
- 2 boxes of stuffing
- 1 five pound bag of potatoes
- 2 cans of vegetables
- 2 cans of fruit
- 1 can of cranberry sauce
- 1 box cake mix & frosting or 1 graham cracker crust & can of pumpkin filling
- 1 box of Jell-O
- 1 lb. of margarine
- 1 box or container of hot drink mix
