B. Football –

1. **Motion:** Approve request by Coach John Vander Schaaf @ \$ (waiting on invoice amount from Tiger) to purchase 22-football jersey's (replace purchased jerseys by Seniors and add lineman numbers never purchased). **Motion approved. P.O. # 730034.**
