 - D. **Motion** to approve added expense for football equipment shipping expense of \$20.00. **Approved** with same PO#730040
 - E. Estimate of Fireworks booth income pending with sales tax and additional credits.
 - F. Reimburse Close-Up Club \$2800.00 for ad sales for 2007-08 Sports Program. Waiting for all profits to come in from Nancy Terpstra.
- IV. Coaches Report:**
 - A. Football: expecting up to 24 varsity players and up to 25 JV
 - B. Varsity played in a 7 on 7 scrimmage with Big Valley Christian last Thursday and plan on another this week at BV.

 - D. Knights apparel- some questions arose on whether minimum order could be multiple sports theme shirts or just one sport per minimum order. Would we be able to sell 100+ shirts for soccer or volleyball? Members agree, that hats should be offered as they have been popular in the past.
 - E. Fireworks booth: Members agree to keep current location for booth next year. A call for a new fireworks coordinator has been issued as Art VanGinkle will retire after 2009, the new coordinator will be required to attend safety meetings this coming spring for 2010 sales.
