

What We Offer

- Our elementary program provides the basis for life-long learning. More than just the basics, we develop their unique gifts through music, fine arts and technology.
- Our new industrial arts program includes an enhanced technology curriculum with the following courses: drafting/C.A.D.; metal works; woodworking; and animal/plant science.
- We offer several AP and Honors classes. Honors English, Honors Anatomy and Physiology, AP Spanish IV, AP Calculus, and AP US History.
- We offer Mock Trial. We placed 3rd in the 2006 county competition, with an RC student receiving the Honorable Judge Cruikshank Spirit Award.
- We participate in Spiritual Emphasis Week (S.E.W.) with many opportunities for community involvement from our students.
- Faculty members contribute over \$10,000 to a faculty scholarship fund that provides tuition assistance to several families.
- The Elementary and Middle School students attend bi-weekly chapels where they praise God and are led in their spiritual growth.
- High School students participate in student-led worship during their bi-weekly chapel time and are challenged in their spiritual growth by featured speakers.
- More than 50% of the middle school and high students participate in instrumental or vocal music. The high school produces two plays a year involving 30-50 students.
- Our K-12 program involves students in various projects such as collecting food for Interfaith Ministries and collecting gifts for Operation Christmas Child.
