Applicants to the John Cambra Agriculture/Mechanics Scholarship Fund (JCAMSF) must: be a high school graduating senior or enrolled college student with a CPA of 2.5 or higher; be a U.S. citizen or legal permanent resident AND a resident of the State of California; be enrolled in a course of study pertaining to agriculture or mechanics for the coming academic year, including junior college prerequisites. For clarification on qualifying agriculture majors, please refer to the National FFA Organization majors' list.

Awards: If selected, the recipient will receive an award of at least \$ 250.

Application Form: Application forms may be obtained by calling (209)471-3400, or accessing the scholarship section of the high school or college websites. The required documents list for a complete application packet is on Page 2 of the application form. Incomplete applications will not be considered. If the applicant is under 18 years of age, the application form must also be signed by applicant's parent or guardian. All information received is confidential and will be reviewed only by the JCAMSF Selection Committee. Incorrect or fraudulent statements may result in the termination of the award. Application packets postmarked after the stated due date will not be considered. All applicants will receive notification of the results of their application. Completed application packets must be submitted (postmarked) by:

Selection: Scholarship recipients are selected based on financial need, academic record, school and community activities, work experience, and mission statement. Signature of applicant and parent/guardian acknowledge that the JCAMSF Selection Committee's decision is final.

<u>Payment of Scholarships:</u> Scholarship payments will be processed upon receipt of valid college enrollment verification. Checks will be made payable and mailed directly to the recipient. Recipients are to notify the Selection Committee of any changes in address and/or school enrollment status and to provide a transcript or progress report when requested.

Make sure you: Read the application carefully; meet all applicable requirements – GPA, field of study, residency; answer all sections thoroughly and honestly; are NEAT and legible when completing the application (typed or printed in blue or black ink); use proper grammar – check spelling, punctuation, etc.; are clear and brief when stating goals and financial need; include in the mission statement your potential service or career in agriculture or mechanics; include all required documents in the application packet – see Page 2 of application; mail the COMPLETE application packet so that it is submitted or postmarked by APRIL 30th.
